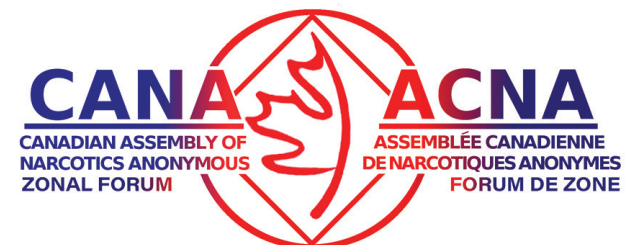


# The Canadian Assembly Zonal Forum
